#### Call to Order: Millie Smith

- President Millie called the Zoom meeting to order at 5:38 PM.
- Doug recorded the minutes.

#### President: Millie Smith

- The June meeting was also done through Zoom; there was some discussion that the club should sign up for its own Zoom account.
- The June 13<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Picnic was a sell-out and a big success.
- The Three Passes Tour was also a big success with 50 participants and a waitlist.
- PCA has instituted new requirements an organizer's report and an observer's report for tours.
- The Ace's game has been cancelled. They credited our deposit so we can carry it over to next yet. Ozzie moved and Deb seconded to carry it over to next year. The motion passed unanimously.
- We will cancel the July 9<sup>th</sup> and July 22<sup>nd</sup> wine socials; we may try to squeeze in a Zoom wine social.
- The Mammoth High Alpine Tour will be cancelled. Barry moved and Deb seconded a motion to cancel. The motion passed unanimously.
- The Concours is cancelled. It will change to a Show and Shine, just for our club. Members can bring their own food if they like, but it will be relatively short in duration. We will not have any club-sponsored food other than coffee and donuts.
- We may consider masks with the SNR logo to encourage and enforce mask-wearing when not eating.
- Millie will E-blast the requirement for masks at Porsches and Pastries. Perhaps an award for the best mask?
- Millie is working with Terry Burns on scheduling the off-road tour for September.
- Bob McLaughlin presented his findings from his Connective Leadership Institute study.
- Kim inquired if there is a mechanism for members to notify the club if they have tested positive for COVID and have attended a club event. We will revisit this in September when we can no longer restrict events to outdoors.
- Karen moved and Ozzie seconded to approve the minutes from the last board meeting; the motion passed unanimously.

- The Treasurer's Report was previously distributed to the directors.
- Balances are \$4,487 in checking and \$16,558 in savings for total cash of \$21,045.
- We should be receiving a \$4 per member rebate from National.
- Karen moved and Beverly seconded to approve the Treasurer's report. The motion passed unanimously.

- Last month we had two new members, two transfers in, and one Test Drive member.
- We have 323 primary members and 204 affiliates for a total of 527.
- Karen is still sending a welcome letter and SNR logo to new members.

- Steve is working on a Nevada City drive, tentatively scheduled for July 25<sup>th</sup>. The directors discussed what to do about lunch – perhaps a box lunch from the Cheese Board? Some members are uncomfortable dining in restaurants.

- Deb and Kim are working together on several events.

- They are rethinking the New Members Breakfast and maybe doing it outdoors, but that would require a tent from Camelot. Toiyabe will give us three rooms and can set tables 10' apart for some good social distancing. Discussing options for mixing up the schedule a bit. Currently doing March to March cutoff for new members. We may ask spouses to sit with each other.
- We need to schedule Volunteer Appreciation Dinner. Perhaps we could do a daytime outdoor event.
- They are concerned that we can't do Oktoberfest indoors, and the weather may not permit an outdoor event.
