- The balance in checking is \$2,627 with \$13,561 in savings for total cash of \$16,188. The PCA National quarterly rebate of \$1,396 was received.
- Barry reviewed the May income and expenses and reported on the Wine Tour. The net loss was \$1,074.
- The PayPal charge for the Wine Tour was \$175, about 4%. We need to calculate that charge into future event budgets.
- The Dust-Off Tour showed a slight loss because the Heyday did not include the service charge in their quote.
- Barry reviewed the event subsidy report for this year.
- Karen moved and Ozzie seconded to approve the Treasurer's report. The motion passed unanimously.

#### Membership Chair: Karen O'Larey

- We had three new members, one transfer in, and one transfer out, with one Test Drive member.
- Total membership stands at 363 primary members and 219 affiliates for total membership of 582.
